Referrals are preferred for insurance coverage and a required for Medicare.

Information required on referrals includes:

- Diagnosis and Diagnosis Code
- Provider signature
- Reason for referral
- Recent labs
- Recent progress notes
- Special indications (e.g. needs 1 on 1, insulin teaching, CGM training, etc.)
